

S2S 2026 Application Process for Gymnastics/Cheerleading Specialty Clinical Experience

Athletico Physical Therapy is proud to offer a Specialty Clinical Experience in the sports of Gymnastics and Cheerleading through our Student to Specialist program, S2S. A limited number of placements are available for DPT students completing their final clinical experience. This rotation offering is primarily Outpatient Orthopedics with exposure to patients who participate in gymnastics and cheerleading with experiences both in the clinic and in the community. The caseload may vary from 5% to 20% of gymnastics/cheerleading patients. Selected students will be placed with a Clinical Instructor who specializes in treating gymnasts, cheerleaders, and dancers. Students will treat the general orthopedic population but will have exposure to gymnasts of all ages and all competitive levels (recreational, X-cel, USAG, high school, and/or collegiate level) and of various disciplines such as men's and women's artistic gymnastics, rhythmic, trampoline and tumbling. Exposure to cheerleaders at the middle school and high school level and on All-Star teams may also be available depending on your location. The student and clinical instructor will treat patients in the clinic and there may be opportunities to shadow at one of our affiliations, participate in onsite screenings, and participate in community outreach events. - Strong Orthopedic background and knowledge of gymnastics/cheerleading terminology
- Exemplary professional behavior and communication skills

Applications will be reviewed by Athletico's Student Clinical Education Team, as well as the Gymnastics and Cheerleading Program Manager. Top applicants will undergo a virtual interview in May or early June, and final decisions will be announced by June 18, 2025. This is a competitive application process as Athletico Physical Therapy has limited Gymnastics and Cheerleading rotations available.

Terms:

- Final clinical experience is defined as a terminal experience immediately preceding graduation.
- Athletico Physical Therapy will accept applications from academic programs which we do not currently hold a contract with. If the applicant is chosen, Athletico will execute a one-time contract.
- If an applicant does not receive a Gymnastics/Cheerleading Specialty Clinical, they may still be considered for a general outpatient orthopedic placement at the request of the DCE.
