

S2S 2025 Application Process for Sports Specialty Clinical Experience

Athletico Physical Therapy is proud to offer a Sports Specialty Physical Therapy Clinical Experience through our Student to Specialist program, S2S. A limited number of placements are available for DPT students completing their final clinical experience. Selected students will be placed with a Clinical Instructor who holds their Sports Certified Specialist (SCS) or an advanced certification in sports performance and treats a large population of youth and adult athletes. Students will focus on high level critical thinking and differential diagnosis using evidence-based treatment. Students will have exposure to techniques, which may include Dry Needling, Blood Flow Restriction, and Instrument Assisted Soft Tissue Mobilization. Students may also be providing community education or participating in sideline experiences based upon their CI. This is a specialty experience, and an application is required.

Requirements:

- Application items to upload:**
 - Resume
 - Letter of Intent
 - Letter of Recommendation from a faculty member
 - Completed DCE Acknowledgement Form
- Final Clinical Experience for 2025
- Strong Orthopedic background and interest in sports
- Exemplary professional behavior and communication skills

Preference: Desire to work in an Outpatient Orthopedic or Sports Medicine setting upon graduation. Licensed Athletic Trainer, Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist, or Certified Personal Training Certificate preferred but not required.

Applications will be reviewed by Athletico's Student Clinical Education Team. Top applicants will undergo a virtual interview in May/June and final decisions will be announced by June 28, 2024. This is a competitive application process. Athletico Physical Therapy has limited Specialty Sports rotations available.

Terms:

- Final clinical experience is defined as a terminal experience immediately preceding graduation.
- Athletico Physical Therapy will accept applications from academic programs which we do not currently hold a contract with. If the applicant is chosen, Athletico will execute a one-time contract.
- If an applicant does not receive a Sports Specialty Clinical, they may still be considered for a general outpatient orthopedic placement at the request of the DCE.
